

### **4-1.3 DECISION NO. D-17**

#### **STORM WATER DISCHARGES FROM CONSTRUCTION SITES**

##### **Issue:**

Guidelines are needed for developing pollution prevention plans in compliance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) for storm water discharges from construction sites.

##### **Decision:**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Storm Water Management For Construction Activities, Developing Pollution Prevention Plans and Best Management Practices, Summary Guidance, EPA 833-R-92-001, October 1992, will apply immediately to all Indian Health Service health care facilities and quarters construction.
